A Retreat in Daily Life: This retreat, while you carry on with all your usual routines, offers an opportunity to commit to more intentional prayer over the six weeks of Lent.

Lent provides a special context for our journey. Just as Jesus considered the cup that he was about to drink, we too can consider the cup of our life: we can explore the loving, creative mystery of our faith.

Most people aren't able to spend time away from work in a peaceful retreat centre to pursue their relationship with God (great as that might be). Yet we may long to deepen that relationship. So we set aside time to retreat, not *away* from our normal life but *in* it – taking time daily to pay attention, to pray and to reflect. There are only two group meetings, at the beginning (3rd March, 3pm) and at the end (14th April, 3pm). Otherwise, pilgrims make their own time for prayer each day, and each week, meet individually with a prayer guide at a time and place you choose together, for sharing and support.
