Hope Into Action Update

We are delighted to share that this week Adele from Hope into Action has found an additional investor and so they are starting to look for a house for tenants to move into. Please do pray for the search, and for the tenants, and the journey God is leading us on as a church family.

Carriers of Hope and Clothing Coventry – UPDATED – PLEASE READ

Carriers are building up to Christmas. Once again this year they will be collecting **filled shoeboxes** for the children of Coventry families in dire need and particularly refugee and asylum-seeking families. You will be able to drop boxes off in church but not until after our 'special week'.

Carriers' have different people and organisations providing 'consumable' supplies weekly. Our '**special week**' is Sunday 6 November and we are asking people to bring suitable donations to church during the 3-Sunday 'fortnight' **23 Oct - 6 Nov**. The items they are particularly needing are:

- tinned tomatoes, sardines in oil, sweetcorn, baked beans, tuna, tinned coconut milk, breakfast cereal, cooking oil, dried kidney beans, chickpeas, black-eyed beans, lentils, long grain rice, pasta;
- jam, honey, tinned fruit, flour and maize meal, fresh ginger, sugar (brown and white), table salt;
- instant drinking chocolate, coffee, tea bags;
- nappies - all sizes and wipes, baby lotion, baby oil, baby shower gel, Aptamil 1 baby milk (no other brands please);
- adult toiletries, toilet rolls and tissues, cleaning products and
- **at this time of year:** tins of goodies for Christmas (chocolates or biscuits).

Other Carriers donations: other items which you might want to donate to Carriers still need to be **taken to them** directly. Sorry but there is not space in church for the storage of other donations and they'd need to be taken at a different place and time. They are currently needing: toasters, kettles, microwaves, vacuum cleaners, clothes' airers.

Clothing Coventry are looking for warm clothing and clothing for plus-sized women (sizes 22-30). In addition, they have launched a campaign to build up their supply of new any sort of socks, Socktober. If you want to donate any socks Fey has offered to take them in if that is easier for you. They have announced that they will **temporarily close** for donations from the start of November, to allow them to reorganise stock.

Since these arrangements can change at short notice I do suggest you phone before visiting.
