Money in = £9,902 including

- £1,830 from funerals and weddings, etc.
- £420 from donations
- £242 from hiring out the church hall

Money out for operating expenses = £11,950 including

- £7,464 Parish Share paid to Diocese
- £505 paid to bell ringers, organist, etc.
- £451 to Diocese for funeral fees

Overall totals for 1 January to 30 September 2022

Total income = £110,246 (incl. £10,000 grant)

Operational expenses = £118,721 plus

Capital/Project spending = £2,425

Carriers of Hope and Clothing Coventry

Carriers are building up to Christmas. Once again this year they will be collecting **filled shoeboxes** for the children of Coventry families in dire need and particularly refugee and asylum-seeking families. As previous years they are asking for a stocking's worth of gifts (toys, games, sweets and other gifts, but not clothes or war-related toys) inside a shoebox. The shoebox should be gift-wrapped, wrapping the lid separately, and labelling it with the age (0-2, 3-5, 6-8, 9-12, 13+) and gender of the child you've packed for. Check their website for full information: www.clothingcoventry.org/christmas You will be able to drop boxes off in church but not until after our 'special week'.

Carriers' have different people and organisations providing 'consumable' supplies weekly. Our turn, our '**special week**', is Sunday 6 November and we are asking people to bring suitable donations to church during the 3-Sunday fortnight **23 Oct - 6 Nov**. The items they are particularly needing are: Tinned tomatoes; Sardines in oil; Breakfast cereal; Jam; Honey; Instant drinking chocolate; Tea bags; Rice; Nappies - all sizes; Aptamil 1 baby milk (no other brands please).

Other Carriers donations: other items which you might want to donate to Carriers still need to be taken to them directly. Sorry but there is not space in church for the storage of other donations and they'd need to be taken at a different place and time. They are currently needing: toasters, kettles, microwaves, vacuum cleaners, clothes' airers.

Clothing Coventry are currently accepting clothing donations again, particularly looking for warm clothing. They have launched a campaign for October, Socktober, to build up their supply of socks. (They only ever want new underwear.) If you want to donate any socks Fey has offered to take them in if that is easier for you.
