Carriers of Hope and Clothing Coventry - Shoebox deadline in just 2 weeks

Thank you very much everyone who contributed to All Saints' Special Week collection for Carriers. You donated a fabulous 18 carrier bags full of useful contributions. Great. As Carriers say regularly: they couldn't do what they do without the help of their supporters.

Carriers currently have 3 Christmas initiatives:

- Once again this year Carriers are collecting **filled shoeboxes** for the children of Coventry families who are in dire need (via Social Services) and particularly refugee and asylum-seeking families. These need to focus on toys. They should not include clothes or war-related toys but can include, say, some sweets or smellies. Wrap a shoebox in festive paper, fill it, close it with an elastic band and label it with the appropriate gender and age band (0-2, 3-5, 6-8, 9-12, 13+). You can drop filled boxes off in church by **Sun 27 Nov**.
- Carriers are seeking **large toys** (good second-hand items). These are needed for a giveaway event planned for early December at which parents can choose an item their children would really appreciate.
- In addition to tins of chocolates or biscuits, Carriers want to give each of their families £15 to allow them to buy a **festive food**. They are seeking **monetary donations** (or supermarket gift cards) for this purpose. This replaces Dinner in a Bag which Carriers have run in previous years. Donations can be made via their website <https://carriersofhope.org.uk/> or their Facebook page or post a cheque to the address below.

Clothing Coventry are **temporarily closed** for donations, to allow them to reorganise stock. When they re-open they will be looking for winter clothing and coats.
