Values Survey - Final Results

During June 2023 we had a series of consultations with the All Saints' congregation regarding values; Simple, Gentle and Connected. We had produced a precis of the initial findings to aid discussion. During the PCC Away Day on 15 July 2023 we recommended that these help inform the Parish Profile, what we are looking for in a new Rector, and also something that we make a point of continuing to reflect on and explore as a church as we go through the next few months.

UHCW have asked Clothing Coventry to collect knitted cardigans for premature babies in Neonatal Baby Unit. They only want cardigans for tiny babies though. If you have any to donate, or can knit any, you can drop them to Clothing Coventry.

Over the summer holidays Clothing Coventry are running a FREE pop-up 'shop' for school uniform items, from blazers and shirts to shoes and trainers and bags. This includes branded items for some schools (certainly including Bluecoat and Coundon Court). Items will be available to anyone struggling to provide uniform for their children. They are also looking for any donations of pre-loved uniform items, which can be taken to the shop. This shop will be open 25 July until 25 Aug, Tues and Thurs, 10:00-14:00 and is being hosted at The Salvation Army, Upper Well St, CV1 4AG.

Carriers of Hope are currently particularly needing buggies and strollers; bunk beds and toddler beds; vacuum cleaners, toasters, kettles, hand/stick blenders, microwaves; pots and pans, dining plates, bowls, and glasses; nappies and wipes; and rugs.
