Carriers of Hope and Clothing Coventry

Carriers' have different people and organisations providing 'consumable' supplies weekly. Our turn, our 'special week', is Sunday 5 November and we are asking people to bring suitable donations to church during the 3-Sunday fortnight 22 Oct - 5 Nov. Since they are ***NOT*** collecting filled shoeboxes this year they will also appreciate Christmas items at this time of year. The items they particularly need are:

- Baby items: nappies (all sizes - especially 5, 6 and 6+) and wipes, baby lotion, baby oil and baby shower gel, nappy bags, baby milk – Aptamil 1 only please.
- Adult toiletries, including sanitary towels (but not tampons)
- Food items: tinned tomatoes, sweetcorn, baked beans, tuna, coconut milk, tinned fruit, cooking oil, dried kidney beans, chickpeas, black eyed beans, lentils, rice, pasta, jam and honey, fresh ginger, sugar, table salt, tea, coffee, flour and maize meal.
- Other items: toilet rolls and tissues, cleaning products, especially washing up liquid & washing powder/tablets.
- Christmas items: children's stationery items, toys & games, sweets & chocolates (as long as they're still in date for Christmas)

Other Carriers donations: other items which you might want to donate to Carriers still need to be taken to them directly. Sorry but there is not space in church for the storage of other donations and they'd need to be taken at a different place and time. They are currently needing: toasters, kettles, microwaves, vacuum cleaners, clothes' airers.

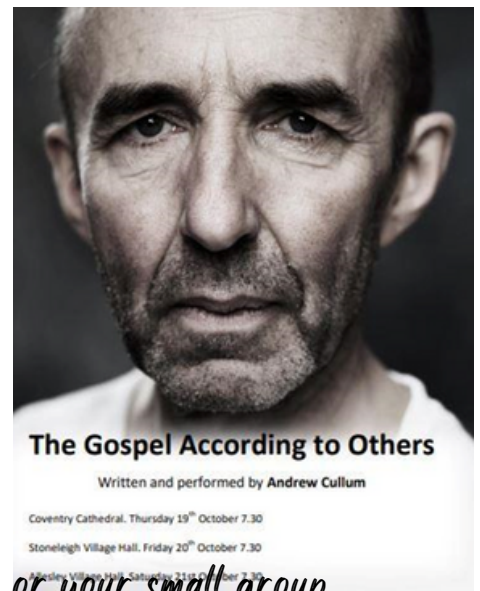
