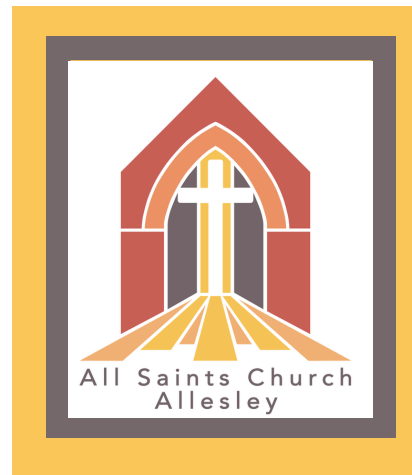
Help Needed!

We need

People:

- 2 willing (or resigned to be helpful) adults to dress as gladiators (cheap muscle suits on amazon??? will make it funny)
- Children dressed as contenders either in red or blue top and shorts that we can pin a gladiator logo on to their t shirt (can be gladiators if they wish)
