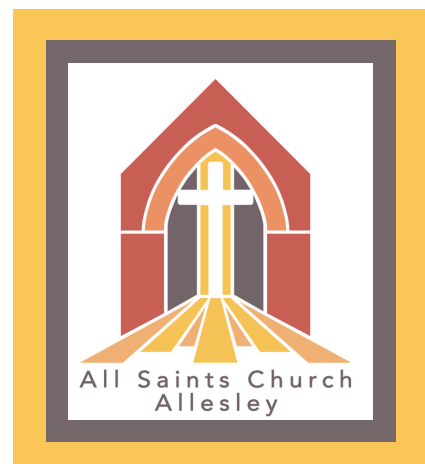

## Tower and Spire Repair Work

In the last Quinquennial Inspection Report in 2023, our architect highlighted essential repair work required on the tower and spire. Contracts have been signed and this is now about to start, hopefully from Monday 8 July, with scaffolding being built to the west and north sides of the tower, all the way up to the spire. This means the tower door will no longer be in use until the project is completed, as there will be a 4m high steel protective wall around the base of the scaffolding.

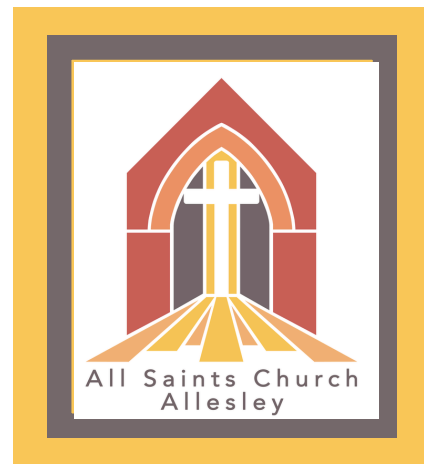
Once the scaffolding is built the contactors, Midland Conservation Ltd, will measure the elements they need to replace, before ordering new stone. There will be a few weeks when it looks like nothing is happening whilst they work the new stone off-site, before bringing it to Allesley and replacing it in situ.

Midland Conservation Ltd expect to complete all the work and remove the scaffolding within 10 - 12 weeks from the start date. During this time they will use our toilet and kitchen facilities as required. For the whole of August and September there will be no bell-ringing to avoid any unnecessary movement in the tower, which might affect the integrity of repairs. Church and hall, and most paths will remain open as normal throughout the works, but there will be contractor vehicles in the car park from time to time. Your patience will be appreciated.

The PCC has agreed to underwriting the cost of these repairs, which is £65,825 + VAT. We should be able to claim back the VAT through the Listed Places of Worship Grant Scheme, and we have applied for grants from other sources too. If you would like to make a contribution to the cost of these essential repairs, then please contact Paul Payne, PCC Treasurer (paulpayne02@aol.com). All contributions will be gratefully received.
