Welcome to All Saints!

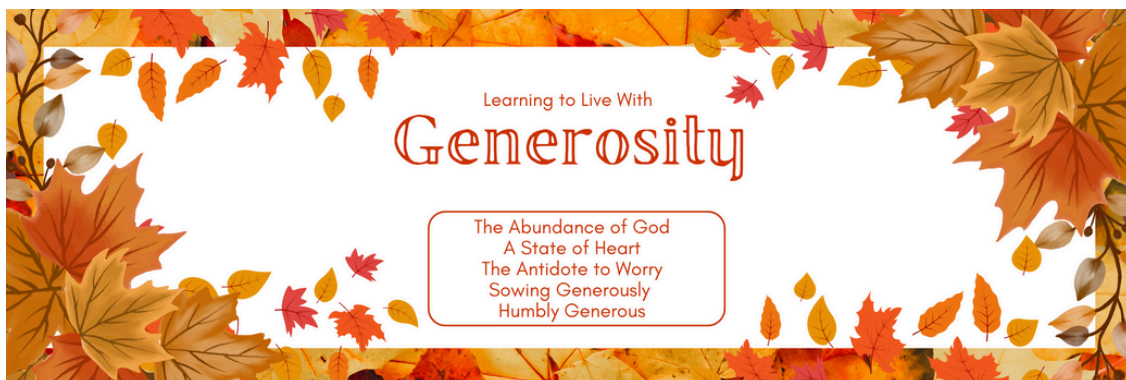
This Focus newsletter is our way of keeping you informed about upcoming events, services and prayer meetings, as well as sharing uplifting stories, and important updates within our church family.



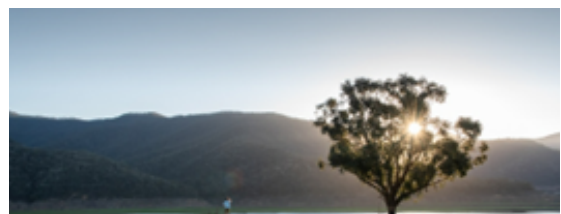
Carriers of Hope and Clothing Coventry
