All Saints are Carriers' 'Donor of the Week' on Sunday 10 November. Donations will be collected after the 10am service. Items being collected:

Baby items: Nappies and wipes, baby lotion, baby oil and baby shower gel, Nappy bags, Baby Milk – Aptamil 1 only please.

Adult Toiletries, including sanitary towels

Food items: tins of tomatoes, sweetcorn, baked beans tuna. tinned coconut milk, tinned fruit. cooking oil, dried kidney beans, chickpeas, black eyed beans, lentils, long grain rice, pasta, jam and honey, fresh ginger, sugar (brown and white), table salt, tea, coffee, flour and maize meal.

Other items: toilet rolls and tissues, cleaning products, especially washing up liquid and washing powder/tablets.. Thanks in anticipation.
