Sherbourne Fields School Visit

This week we had a visit from a class from Sherbourne Fields School, which is an all age special school in our Parish for pupils with a broad spectrum of need, including physical disabilities, medical condition and learning needs. We had a wonderful time pretending to baptise baby dolls (we got soggy!), waving flags to some of our favourite church songs, pretending to sip wine from our special silver cups and admiring the big organ pipes! The children were all so brilliant in their individual interests and we loved welcoming them into church to explain what a special place it is for us and how much God loves each one of them.

From Coventry City Mission Giving Tree Project:

“Thank you for your help with our Giving Tree Project this Christmas. We have found we are helping more and more local children each year and were expecting an increase from the 1589 children we helped in 2024. However, we didn’t expect the size of increase we actually received! This year we provided gifts for 2201 children from 941 local families. This increase of an EXTRA 612 children was unprecedented and did put a strain on our resources, but as Christians we trust God that he will provide and we found that you - our supporters - rose to the challenge. We are so grateful for the role you played in donating gifts. This year we again had 6 locations across the city where families could choose to collect their gifts from; some of these ran activities for the children too. Santa joined us at the Coventry City Mission sessions and he gave selection boxes to all of the children in addition to the gifts that they would later receive. The families took the gifts home at the end of the session with wrapping paper to wrap them and hide until Christmas morning. We have received a number of thank you messages from the parents who are so grateful for our support at this challenging time.”
