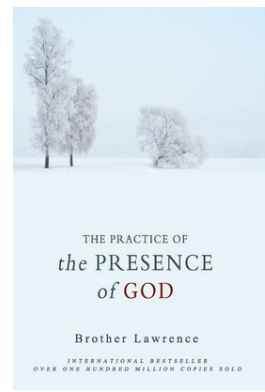
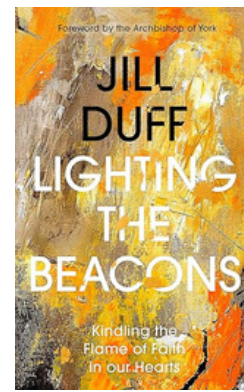
New Wine - 28th July - 2nd August 2026
