PCC & Church Warden Elections

The PCC is the governing committee of the Church which makes key strategic decisions about the direction of our Church. **We have 6 spaces coming up to serve on the PCC** from after our APCM on the 17th May, when elections take place. We also have the opportunity to serve as a church warden, another key role in our Church. If you are interested in either, please speak to Sarah, Tracy or Julie.

Joining the Electoral Roll is a key way in the Church of England to show you belong to a certain church. If All Saints is your Church, please make sure you are on our electoral roll! It allows you to vote for our PCC representatives and our church wardens in May's APCM. To join the roll you need to be over 16, baptised, and be either a resident in the Parish, or a regular attender for 6 months, or would have been a regular attender for 6 months had you not been unwell.
