FINAL DAY to join the Electoral Roll: this is a key way in the Church of England to show you belong to a certain church. If All Saints is your Church, please join our electoral roll! It allows you to vote for our PCC representatives and our church wardens in May’s APCM. To join the roll you need to be over 16, baptised, and be either a resident in the Parish, or a regular attender for 6 months, or would have been a regular attender for 6 months had you not been unwell.
