How can I book?

To use the prayer room you must book - sign up via the link or scan the QR code above.

You cannot attend without a booking made in advance.

Where is it and how can I access the room?

It is located in the small meeting room. Once you have made a booking you will receive an email with full access details.

How long is my session?

A session is 50 minutes but you are able to book more than one session if you wish.

Can I come with a friend or in a group?

Coming as part of a group or with a friend is a great idea. You should indicate who will be attending when you book in.

Can I bring my child?

Parents/guardians are more than welcome to do so. The prayer room will best suit Key-Stage 2 children and up. If you bring your child you must supervise them at all times. We also have prayer trails in the Churchyard if you prefer.

I am in secondary school and under 18, can I use the prayer room?

You absolutely can use the prayer room! You can come along to our dedicated Youth Hangout or come with a parent.

Can I book in overnight?

In some instances it is possible to book overnight, to discuss this further please email ann@allesleychurch.org.uk.

Will I be alone in the Prayer Room or Church?

When booking, you can select "Book Exclusive Use" to have sole use of the Prayer Room during your slot. If not selected, others may book the same time. Please note there may still be other users in the Church hall, office, or Main Church while you use the Prayer Room.
